Choose a Full or Half Veggie CSA Share

FULL Shares: Each week for 18 weeks (target start date: June 16, 2021), you'll receive a box of veggies and herbs intended for a family

of 4 enthusiastic veggie eaters. Or, split it among households as you like.

HALF Shares: Each week for 18 weeks, you'll receive a smaller box of veggies and herbs intended for 2 people.

Full Share

If you can pay in full by March 15, 2021, choose the Early Bird Discount below. Or, make an initial payment of \$100 now & the remainder of \$440 by June 1, 2021 ("Regular" option).

Half Share

If you can pay in full by March 15, 2021, choose the Early Bird Discount below. Or, make an initial payment of \$50 now & the remainder of \$310 by June 1, 2021 ("Regular" option).

Flower Shares

I also offer shares of certified organic flowers grown at Stone's Throw Farm. A Flower Share consists of a beautiful fresh bouquet every week for 8 weeks, with a target start date of July 21, 2021. Bouquets will be delivered to Duluth on Wednesdays with our Veggie CSA Shares, or to a location TBD if you do not also have a Veggie Share. If you will be unable to collect your bouquet on a certain week, you can have a friend pick it up and enjoy it, or talk to Catherine in advance about the possibility of rescheduling your bouquet.

Thanksgiving & Preserving Shares

Please wait to pay until you receive your vegetables.
These items are not part of the regular CSA share; they are extra vegetables above and beyond what you receive in a share. Availability is not guaranteed and orders will be filled on a first-ordered, first received basis.

Order Thanksgiving Shares (Don't pay yet)

___ Boxes at \$55 each for 35 lbs of storage vegetables (including winter squash, potatoes, carrots, onions) plus green veggies, delivered in early November.

Order Green Bean Preserving Shares (Don't pay yet)

___ I'd like to pick preserving beans this summer.
(Simply indicate your interest at this point.)

Order Canning Tomato Shares (Don't pay yet)

___ Boxes at \$36/box; approx. 20 lbs of tomatoes suitable for sauce, salsa, dehydrating, etc.

Order Basil Preserving Shares (Don't pay yet)

___ Pounds at \$12/lb (2-3 lbs is typical)

Payment Instructions

- For Thanksgiving and Preserving Shares: Please order now, but **please DON'T pay now**.
- For Veggie and Flower CSA Shares: A deposit or full payment is due upon sign-up.
- Please mail payments to Stone's Throw Farm, PO Box 124, Wrenshall, MN 55797. Checks can be made out to Stone's Throw Farm.
- If you prefer to pay via PayPal, please send your payment(s) to my PayPal account at stonethrowmn@gmail.com.
- To receive the early bird discount, your full CSA share payment must be received by **March 15, 2021**.
- If you are making an initial payment now, the balance is due on **June 1, 2021**. Payments can be made in any amount until that time. If you are unable to pay in full by June 1st, please contact Catherine to work out a payment plan.
- If additional shareholders (households you are splitting your share with) are sending payments directly to the farm, please include the name of the "Primary Shareholder" (the person who filled out this form) in the memo line. I'll send you an email confirmation with each payment.

CSA Shared Risk Agreement

Community-Supported Agriculture involves shared risk and shared rewards for the farmer and the consumer. Farm members each purchase an equal share of the season's harvest, not a certain volume or weight of vegetables. Every year your share will be a little different, because every year growing conditions are a little different.

The risk is crop shortages or losses, which would be reflected in your share box. The reward is that if we have a great season, you'll receive a lot of high-quality vegetables! Even in 2012 (the year of the flood), we only sustained a few significant crop losses. The diversity of crops grown helps ensure we always have plenty of good food, and your commitment and support gives us (your farmers) plenty of motivation to work hard and do our best for you.

We've enjoyed productive growing seasons in the past and plan for the same this year. Our farm is Certified Organic, and our goal is to improve the health of the soil, plants, animals, and people at Stone's Throw Farm.
